



Come Tour the Home of Sarah Wells and William Bull

The historic homestead of 18<sup>th</sup> century pioneers William Bull and Sarah Wells will be open to the public on Saturday June 15 from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm as part of the ILoveNY Path Through History events taking place throughout New York state. See the nearly 300 year-old Bull Stone House and New World Dutch Barn built by William Bull and Sarah Wells. At 16 years old, Sarah was the first woman of European decent to settle the interior of Orange County. She and William Bull were the first recorded marriage of settlers in the town of Goshen.
